If you are not certain how to locate Google Services (Products), do the following:

1. Log into Gmail by clicking the Gmail button on the [Community System page](#), or by going directly to <http://gmail.worcester.edu> .
2. On the upper left-hand side of the window, click the link titled **More** followed by **Even More**. The following Web page listing Google products should display:
