

**Q: How do I locate my wireless card's MAC address in my Laptop Computer?**

A: To find the MAC address you will need to use the command prompt and search for the IP Configuration of your wireless card.

- Click **Start > Run**. You will see the **Run** pop-up window.
- Type **Cmd** in the pop-up window's text box. Click **OK**.
- You will see the **cmd** dos window.
- At the **Z:\** prompt, type **ipconfig/all**
- Press **Enter**.
- You will see a listing of all your network cards.
- Under the description of the network card's description is the **Physical Address**. This is the **MAC Address**.
- If more than one Physical Address is listed, you can find your wireless card by checking the **Description**.
- Select the MAC address that is listed with the Description of your wireless card.



- Write Your MAC address down. (It will be similar to: 00-03-48-25-6F)
